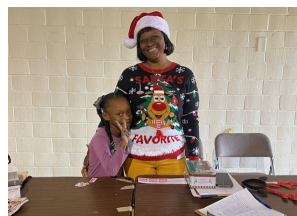
ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY
